## Accessibility Grant for Neurological Inclusion

The Oriol Foundation's Accessibility Grant for Neurological Inclusion provides financial support to registered nonprofits, community groups, and public-serving organizations working to make public events more inclusive for individuals living with neurological disorders. This grant helps reduce barriers for individuals with conditions such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), ADHD, Parkinson's, Alzheimer's, epilepsy, sensory processing disorders, and other forms of dementia or neurological conditions.
